## Great Yarmouth Pleasure Beach

Where? South Beach Parade, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, NR30 3EH. It's 10 miles and 25 minutes along the A12.

Spread over nine acres, the Pleasure Beach offers great family fun; incredible white-knuckle rides to exhilarate and thrill to keep the children happy for hours, and beautiful water attractions to allow a moment to get your breath back! It's so popular it found its place in the top 10 UK free-entry amusement parks in 2012.

Where? 34 Marine Parade, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, NR30 2EN. It's 8.2 miles and 18 minutes via Beccles Road/A134 and A12.

Come and get a taste of 125 years of British history through Yesterday's World – 20,000sq ft. of nostalgia with over 150,000 artefacts inside! Journey through incredibly life-size street scenes, with life-like smells and sounds to take you back in time. All displays are careful recreations of their natural habitats. Become a rock-pool explorer and touch a crab and a starfish as you discover the creatures living on the coastline, in native and tropical rock-pools. Watch our fun, incisive talks and feeding demonstrations throughout the day and test your creature knowledge by taking part in our free kids quiz trail. At every step there are amazing creatures to find, observe and learn about.

Where? Central Seafront, Marine Parade, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, NR30 3AH. It's 7.3 miles 18 minutes via Beccles Road/A134.

Come and have a look at this amazing reptile rescue centre, offering you the chance to get up close with lizards, turtles, snakes and all manner of creatures – even an alligator, named Goliath, if you're brave enough to venture through the tarantula tunnel...
